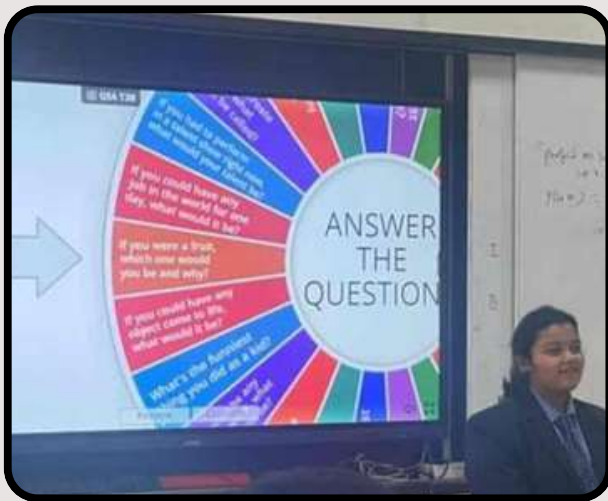

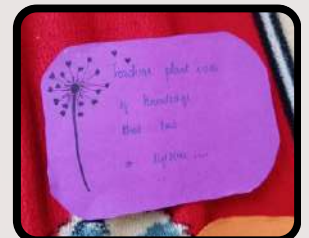
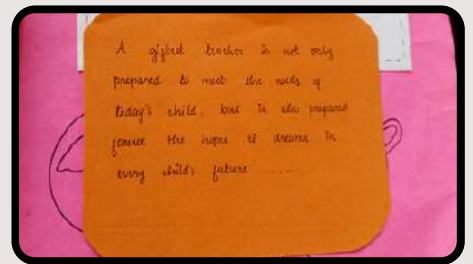
ROLE OF A TEACHER IN STUDENT'S LIFE
